SPEAKERS

Dean Hendrickson, DVM, MS, DACVS
Colorado State University - Fort Collins, CO



Dr. Hendrickson received his DVM from Colorado State University in 1988, and completed an Equine Surgery and Medicine Internship at the University of Sydney, Sydney Australia in 1989. He was accepted into and completed the three year combined

Large Animal Surgery Residency and Masters of Science program at Cornell University in 1992. He became a faculty member in the Department of Surgical Sciences at the School of Veterinary Medicine at the University of Wisconsin-Madison in August 1992. He joined the Department of Clinical Sciences at Colorado State University in December 1994. As an Equine Surgeon at CSU he is involved in all aspects of Equine Surgery including orthopedics and soft tissue. He has spoken internationally on topics including wound care, minimally invasive surgery and orthopedics. He completed a textbook on Equine Wound Care and the 4th Edition of Turner and McIlwraith's Large Animal Surgical Techniques.

MJ Redman, DVM, DAVDC
Animal Dental Care & Oral Surgery - Loveland, CO



Dr. Redman graduated from WSU CVM in 1998. She was a general practitioner in AZ and WA (mixed animal, equine and small animal) until she started an alternate pathway dental residency with Dr. Pat Frost in Portland OR in 2007. Dr. Redman transitioned to dentistry-only practice in 2011 when she moved to Maryland to join the Animal Dental Center in Maryland.

In 2014, She moved to San Antonio TX to work at MissionVet. Dr. Redman joined Animal Dental Care & Oral Surgery in Colorado Springs in 2018. When ADCOS purchased a dentistry business in Loveland, Dr. Redman transitioned to working in Four Seasons Veterinary Specialists. She serves on the Residency Program Advocacy Committee and the Board of Directors for the American Veterinary Dental College. Dr. Redman lives in Fort Collins with her husband (retired Army and now a nursing student), two dogs and six cats. She is a member of the Fort Follies cycling team and swims with Loveland Masters Swim Club. She loves reading and is an avid birder.

Laminitis - This presentation will cover basic concepts of the etiology, diagnosis and treatment of laminitis. Focus will be on treatments that lend themselves to use in the field setting.

Principles of Lameness Examination -This presentation will cover the basics of lameness examination including peripheral nerve blocks. There will be multiple videos of lameness examples used in the presentation.

Treating traumatic injuries to synovial structures -

This presentation will cover methods of diagnosis and treatment for injuries to synovial structures.

Open Wide! The Awake Oral Exam - This lecture will cover oral pathology that can be diagnosed in the awake dog and cat as well as how to discuss treatment options and prognosis with the owner. Common oral health issues in the juvenile as well as the adult patient will be reviewed.

Oral Tumors: It's Not all Bad News - This lecture will cover different presentations, diagnostic and treatment options for oral masses in the dog and cat. Specific topics will include lesions that may be mistaken for neoplasia and how to get the most out of a biopsy and staging.

Periodontal Disease - Periodontal disease is the most common oral disease of dogs and cats and can be frustrating for clients due to its chronic nature. Topics for discussion include diagnostics, treatment and home dental care products.

Stomatitis - This lecture will cover what we currently know about the etiology, diagnosis and treatment of this painful condition in cats and dogs as well as what new treatments are on the horizon.
